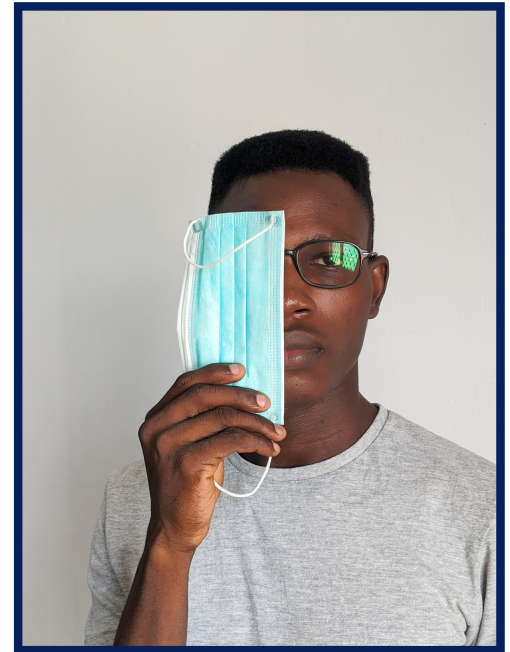


## Gearing Up for a Clean and Safe Welcome Back

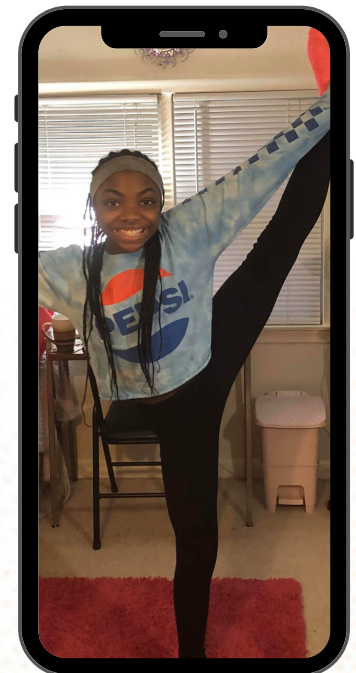
## Summer Camp In Action

CEDS will continue virtual classes throughout the week to keep both students and adults active and ready to perform when the day comes.

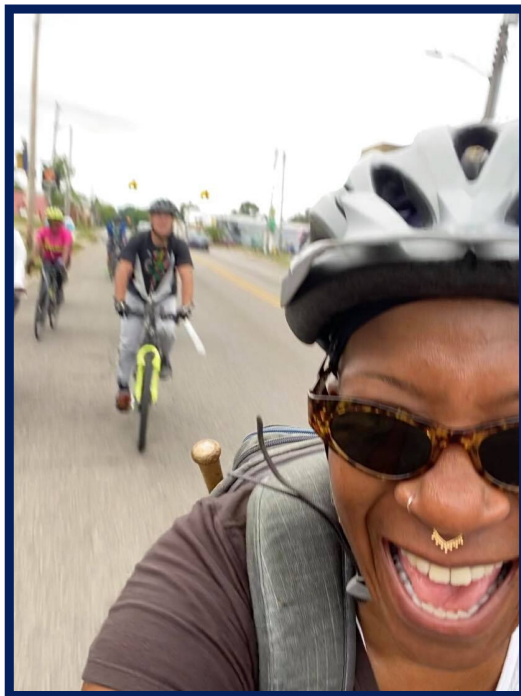




## Smooth Steppers Stepping Back In
